SAFE FUELING PROCEDURES

Please remember to not fill your boat completely when going back to your storage shelf. Gasoline expands with summer temperatures and will burp out of your side vent. This can be a fire hazard and could cause damage to the boats beside and below you. We will be happy to provide the service of adding gas to your boat before your next launch. Just let us know.

BLUE PINS

Please look for the new Blue Pin on your boat. We wanted to improve our services by furnishing a silent communication for your boat movements. Now when you have finished boating and are ready to be put back on your shelf, clip the Blue Pin to your steering wheel. We will then retrieve your boat, fresh water rinse your engines, rinse the outside of the boat from the rub rail down, turn your batteries off and return the boat to its shelf.

SPRING CLEANING

Any items not stowed on board your boat are subject to be discarded after May 15th. We will be cleaning the Rack Storage building and work rack area. If you want it, get it before the 15th and remove it from the marina. Old outboard motors and parts will be recycled for the metals. Is your trailer in our trailer yard? Let us know. Unidentified trailers will be removed from the property after May 15th.

WATER CONSERVATION TIPS

1. Adjust sprinklers to water only the lawn and not house, sidewalk or street. Turn timers off in rainy season.
2. Good hose nozzles will save water while washing your vehicles and boats. This prevents wasted water onto the ground.
